POSITION: Music Instructor

OBJECTIVE: Share your knowledge and skills to the benefit of those impacted by cancer

ROLE DESCRIPTION:

- Assess the abilities of your students to ensure they can participate in the class with or without options that adapt to their physical needs
- Demonstrate a positive attitude and actions through a display of courtesy, service, cooperation, hospitality, sensitivity, and professionalism to GCTC members
- Report accidents and injuries to staff as soon as possible
- Above all, make the class fun and enjoyable for all GCTC members

- Certification and at least 2 years' experience in your field of study if you are teaching one of the following classes: music composition, singing, instrument playing, etc.
- Excellent communication skills
- Ability to lead and motivate a group class
- Ability and enthusiasm to work with youth and young adults
