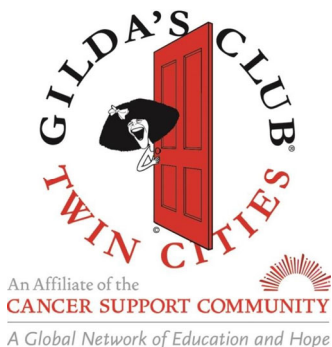
Whatever holiday you celebrate in the month of December, join your Gilda's Club community to celebrate the love and support we share.

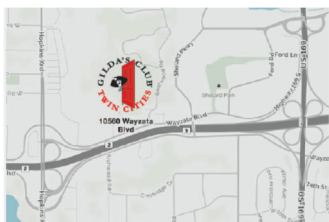

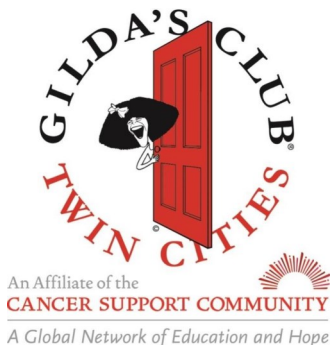
